## Chapter 13 Character Response

### Whole Group Activity:

A major event happened in chapter 12. What was that major event? (*Chris encountered the chicken nugget man.*) How did Chris respond to the Chicken Nugget Man? Look at the details at the end of chapter 12 as well as in chapter 13. Create a circle map of the details.

Have students copy the circle map as you create the class copy. Once finished, have them go through and circle the actions that seem odd for Chris to do in **green** and highlight the ones they think are normal in **blue**. Then have them pick one blue and one green event and explain in writing why they classified that event as odd or normal.

### Assessment:

Review the students explanations. These should give you some insight as to how the students have comprehended other parts of the book. For example, if they think that it seems normal for Chris to sit in his desk for the rest of the afternoon and forget about the Chicken Nugget Man because this is consistent with Chris's character, that allows you to understand that the student understands the characterization of Chris.
